INTRODUCTION:

WHAT IS A UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM ANNUAL PERFORMANCE AND EXPENDITURES COMPLETION REPORT?

The UPWP Annual Performance and Expenditures Completion Report for FY 2021 presents a summary of the activities and products completed by the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (Evansville MPO) during FY 2021. The report describes the progress attained in completing each of the work elements contained in the approved FY 2021 & FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program.

The following pages include a description of the status, related products, and expenditures for each work element contained in the FY 2021 portion of the Unified Planning Work Program. The expenditure figures represent total costs associated with completion of each of the work elements. The sources of funds and abbreviations used to denote these sources are shown in the next section. WHAT IS A METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION?

The Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (EMPO) was established in 1969. Federal law requires that all urbanized areas over 50,000 residents establish metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) to undertake a continuous, cooperative, and comprehensive "3C" transportation planning process. As the designated agency responsible for conducting this planning process in the Evansville-Henderson urbanized areas, the EMPO facilitates transportation policy development, planning and programming in Vanderburgh, Warrick, and Henderson Counties, plus a small area of eastern Posey County.
