Evansville MPO Transportation Improvement Program Amendment:

Public review and comment is being sought by the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (EMPO) concerning a proposed amendment to the 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Evansville-Henderson Urbanized Area as described below:

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) requested the following amendment:

ID# 02-382 CS-1372: Improve safety and congestion on Watson Lane from Green River Rd to Sunset Lane. Add project for Preliminary Engineering (PE) in FY 2019, Right of Way (RW) in FY 2020 and Utilities (UT) in FY 2021. PE costs of \$400,000, RW costs of \$1,400,000 and UT costs of \$1,400,000 will be funded with State Construction High Priority Projects (SPP) funding. CN cost to complete outside the TIP period is \$5,000,000.

The proposed amendment will be acted on at the EMPO Policy Committee Meeting to be held at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 12, 2018. The meeting is open to the public and will be held in Room 301 of the Evansville Civic Center Complex located at 1 N.W. MLK Jr. Blvd., Evansville, IN 47708.
