Evansville MPO Transportation Improvement Program Amendment:

Public review and comment is being sought by the Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (EMPO) concerning a proposed amendment to the 2018-2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the Evansville-Henderson Urbanized Area as described below:

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) requested the following amendment:

Item#02-9008 US 41: Intersection with KY 2097. Preliminary design and study to determine low cost improvements at this and various other locations in KYTC District 2. Project also includes four additional District 2 intersections outside the MPO Planning Area. Add project for Preliminary Engineering (PE) in FY 2018. PE costs of \$150,000 will be funded with 100% federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds and a soft match provided by Kentucky Toll Credits.

The proposed amendment will be acted on at the EMPO Policy Committee Meeting to be held at 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 7, 2017. The meeting is open to the public and will be held in Room 301 of the Evansville Civic Center Complex located at 1 N.W. MLK Jr. Blvd., Evansville, IN 47708.
