

**DRAFT TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM RELEASED
NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD**

The Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization (EMPO) has completed a draft of the proposed 2018 – 2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The TIP documents transportation projects for the next four years for the City of Evansville; the City of Henderson; the Town of Newburgh; and Vanderburgh, Warrick, and Henderson Counties. A draft of the TIP may be viewed at the EMPO office, the Henderson City-County Plan Commission and City Manager's office, the Newburgh and Boonville town halls and select area libraries. The draft is also available online at www.evansvillempo.com.

Open Houses for information exchange on the draft FY 2018-2021 TIP, as well as other transportation planning issues, will be held between 4:30 and 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 13th at the Washington Square Mall (Food Court), South Green River Road, Evansville, IN; 4:30-6 p.m. Monday, April 17th at the Evansville Central Library, 200 SE Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd., Evansville, IN (Browning Rm. B); and 4:30-6 p.m. Wednesday, April 19th at the Henderson County Public Library, 101 South Main Street, Henderson, KY. All are welcome and encouraged to attend.
