Rusty Fowler directed the meeting.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Dan Saylor made a motion for approval and Buzzy Newman seconded the motion; motion carried.

3. OLD BUSINESS

a. Project Update - presented by Pam Drach

City of Evansville

- <u>Covert Ave:</u> Asphalt paving from US 41 to Vann Ave is complete. Pavement markings are planned for installation the week after Labor Day with signal items to follow.
- Walnut St Phase 1 (US 41 to Weinbach Ave): Construction activities are complete and the corridor is open to traffic.
- Walnut St Phase 2 (Weinbach Ave to Vann Ave): One parcel remains in the condemnation process. Final Tracings packet is to be submitted October 4, 2021. Letting moved to January 12, 2022.
- Walnut St Phase 3 (MLK Jr Blvd to US 41): Final environmental document has been submitted. Preliminary field check rescheduled for mid-October to allow for additional utility coordination.
- <u>Signal Preemption:</u> Construction activities are underway (approx. 80% complete) and are expected to be complete in October 2021.
- Signal Modernization (Green River and Washington): Construction is approximately 90% complete.

Vanderburgh County

- <u>Franklin St Bridge:</u> A final field check was held on August 20, 2021; a levee permit was approved by the commissioners on August 17, 2021; DNR construction in a floodway permit was approved on July 28, 2021; the environmental document was approved on July 12, 2021.
- Oak Hill Rd (Eastwood Dr to Millersburg Rd): The right of way (r/w) is being evaluated on a number of parcels in order to determine if the permanent r/w limits can be reduced with a combination of permanent and temporary r/w; design work and utility coordination is continuing.
- Oak Hill Rd (Lynch Rd to St George Rd): State 1 plans were submitted to INDOT on July 22, 2021.

Warrick County

- Bell Rd: North of Oak Grove, utility relocation is complete and roadway construction is ongoing.
- Warrick Trails SRTS: Utility relocations are ongoing. Trail construction is underway.
- <u>Telephone Rd:</u> Utility coordination is underway.

City/County of Henderson

• Wathen Lane: Environmental document approval expected in mid-October.

KYTC

• Watson Lane: Tentative joint inspection meeting proposed for October.

INDOT Updates – presented by Rusty Fowler, INDOT

- (B-43148) US 41 Bridge over Pigeon Creek: Pavement work is ongoing. Bridge has been demolished. Piling work should begin in a few weeks.
- (R-39921) US 66 at Epworth Rd: Revised Stage 2 for dual displaced left to be submitted before end of September. Environmental work is ongoing. Public hearing is anticipated in late fall or early winter.
- (R-37845) US 41 at Hillsdale Rd: INDOT Legal and CSX Legal meeting to discuss easement terms on September 10, 2021.

- (R-41410) US 41 from N of SR 66/SR 62 (Lloyd Expwy) to N of SR 66 (Diamond Ave): Finalizing roadway profile, Traffic Management Plan stakeholder meeting scheduled for September 22, 2021.
- (B-42876) US 41 Pedestrian Walk at US 41 and Washington: Still working through the Section 106 process which is required due to the historic properties in the area. Once that is complete the NEPA document can be submitted for review and released for public involvement.
- (R-42287) SR 62 from Rosenberger Ave to Wabash Ave; US 41 over SR 66/Diamond (including various intersections improvements from Rosenberger Ave to Cross Pointe Blvd): Working through revision requests from the Stage 1 review. Determining pavement replacement options for roadway and intersection improvements. Started development on west side intersections. Traffic Management Plan stakeholder meeting is anticipated in mid-October.

Rusty Fowler mentioned that the US 41 and I 69 high-mast lighting project has been awarded and there is a Notice to Proceed. A preconstruction meeting was held last week and work will probably begin this fall.

He also mentioned the IDIQ project at US 41 and SR 57. Traffic should be impacted for a few more weeks for patching. He estimates it will be finished in about two weeks.

This item was informational and did not require a committee action.

4. NEW BUSINESS

a. FY 2021 Performance and Expenditures Completion Report – presented by Kari Akin

The Annual Unified Planning Work Program Performance and Expenditures Completion Report for FY 2021 presents a summary of the activities and products completed by the Evansville MPO during FY 2021 (July 1, 2020 – June 30, 2021). Described in the report is progress attained in completing each of the work elements contained in the approved FY 2021 and FY 2022 Unified Planning Work Program. This report is submitted to Indiana and Kentucky state agencies by September 20th and to FHWA by September 30th of each year.

Each work element includes a purpose, finished products, and funds expended. The document also includes budget and expenditure summary tables for each funding source and staff hours per element.

The electronic copy will be available by September 8th on the MPO website at <u>www.evansvillempo.com</u> under "Publications and Links" and "Finance". Hard copies are available upon request.

This item was informational and did not require a committee action.

b. Voluntary Leave Transfer Program Policy – presented by Kari Akin

The Evansville MPO seeks approval to add 2.90.211, a Voluntary Leave Transfer Program, to the EMPO Employee Handbook. Under the Voluntary Leave Transfer Program (VLTP), a covered employee may donate annual leave *directly* to another employee who has a personal or family medical emergency and who has exhausted his or her available paid leave (vacation, sick, and personal). There is no limit on the amount of donated annual leave a leave recipient may receive from the leave donor(s); however, any unused donated leave must be returned to the leave donor(s) when the medical emergency ends.

d. TIP Modifications - presented by Pam Drach

The City of Evansville requested the following modification on July 26, 2021:

<u>Des# 1802795:</u> Signal visibility improvements: Replace 8" signal heads with 12" signal heads in the Evansville signal system. Move the construction from FY 2021 to FY 2022.

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) requested the following emergency amendment on July 29, 2021:

<u>Des# 2100287:</u> Safety Revisions: Development of the Statewide Highway/Rail Grade Crossing Safety Action Plan. Add Preliminary Engineering (PE) in FY 2022 at a total cost of \$100,000. Costs will be funded with 90% Federal HSIP and a 10% state match.

Vanderburgh County requested the following modification on August 4, 2021:

<u>Des# 1802074:</u> Oak Hill Rd from Eastwood Dr to Millersburg Rd: Add Right of Way (RW) in FY 2022 for a total of \$750,000 using 100% local funding.

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) requested the following modification on August 26, 2021:

<u>Des# 1902031:</u> Various locations in the Vincennes District (Contract T-42464): Curve sign and marking visibility improvements project. Increase Construction (CN) funding from \$750,000 to \$1,337,000 and move CN from FY 2022 to FY 2023. Costs will be funded with 90% Federal HSIP and a 10% state match.

The Evansville Metropolitan Planning Organization processed the following administrative modifications to the FY 2022-2026 TIP on September 2, 2021:

Wathen Lane form US 60 to the City limits: Add the right of way and utility phases previously listed for FY 2021 obligation to FY 2022. The phases will be funded with a combination of Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) funding, Federal SHN funds and local match.

<u>ID# 02-321:</u> Green River Rd from Bend Gate Rd to Osage Dr: Move Construction (CN) from FY 2022 to FY 2023. The phase will be funded with Federal TE/TAP funds and local match.

This item was informational and did not require a committee action.

e. Call for Projects Amendment - presented by Pam Drach

Based on feedback from the City and County engineers and following an internal review, it is recommended that the construction inspection policy presented in the project call be revised as follows:

It is advised that neither Consultants nor subconsultants who prepare engineering construction plans or construction contract bid documents for a project programmed for EMPO Construction Engineering/Inspection funding shall be associated with construction inspection activities for plans or bid documents they prepared.

John Stoll made a motion for approval and Buzzy Newman seconded the motion; motion carried.

f. Kentucky SHIFT Regional Boost Project Selection – presented by Laura Lamb

One of the final steps in the SHIFT Kentucky Ahead statewide prioritization process for roadway projects is the selection of "Boost" projects. All of the projects listed below were "sponsored" either by the EMPO, in coordination with the City of Henderson and Henderson County, or the KYTC District 2 from the CHAF (Continuous Highway Analysis Framework) database of currently unfunded projects. The EMPO is allotted three Boost Projects which will each receive an additional 15 points added to the KYTC Quantitative Score to increase the potential ranking going into the statewide selection of projects vying for funding by the Kentucky Legislature. The EMPO has selected the three highlighted projects below. Public comment will be accepted on the proposed selection starting September 2nd and continuing through the EMPO public meetings scheduled on September 9th.
