2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

3. OLD BUSINESS

a. Project Update - presented by Pam Drach

City of Evansville

• Walnut St Phase 3 (MLK Jr Blvd to US 41): Utility relocations underway. From Weinbach to Boeke, all concrete has been poured for the multi-use trail, driveways, sidewalks and curb ramps. From Boeke to Vann, contractor has finished the installation of all the 30" force main and storm sewer within this phase.

Warrick County

- <u>Telephone Rd (Bell Rd to Fuquay Rd):</u> Right of way acquisition underway with 75 of 79 parcels secured. Permits are secured. Utility work plans are being submitted.
- Epworth Rd (SR 662 to s of SR 66): Draft Traffic Study, Hydraulic Study, and Archeology Study completed. Planning a preliminary field check for October 2023.

City/County of Henderson

- Green River Rd: Sixteen parcels are secured. Two remain in negotiations. Targeting a spring 2024 project letting.
- <u>Wathen Lane:</u> The consultant submitted the bid letting documents to KYTC. HMG is in process of relocating gas mains along the corridor and completion expected by fall. Water relocations are part of the contract work.

KYTC

• <u>Watson Ln:</u> Appraisal activities are underway. Utility agreements are in place and the utility plans have been requested and are due for submittal in October.

- (B-43148) US 41 Bridge over Pigeon Creek: Project complete.
- (R-39421) US 66 (between New Harmony Rd and Detroy Rd): Pre-construction meeting held April 21, 2023; held meeting for survey issues/correction.
- (B-42876) US 41 Pedestrian Walk at Washington Ave: Low bid was not awardable; reletting on the August 9, 2023 letting.
- (R-41410) US 41 from SR 66/SR 62 (Lloyd) to SR 66 (Diamond): Identifying final utility conflicts and relocations; project moved to the October 12, 2023 letting.
- (R-44898) Various intersection improvements on SR 66: Environmental document submitted to Federal Highway on July 7, 2023; working through reimbursable agreements with utilities.

c. Agreement between METS and EMPO for Grant and Financial Reporting – presented by Kari Akin

The Evansville MPO requests the approval of the agreement for services to assist METS with grants and financial reporting of their grants for CY 2023. Compensation will be \$50,000 in local funds. Legal services have reviewed the document and BPW approved the METS signatures on June 29, 2023.

Jack Corn asked to confirm that there are no changes in this agreement from last year. Kari Akin confirmed no changes were made from the year before. Todd Robertson asked again because he understood there was an increase in the pay. Kari stated that there is an increase in pay, either \$45,600 or \$46,500. Todd wanted to make sure that was clear to everyone. He also wanted to let everyone know that this is in the METS budget, but the 2024 METS budget has not yet been approved by Council.
