

## EVANSVILLE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TECHNICAL COMMITTEE MINUTES

Regular meeting held at 10:00 a.m. in Room 318 Civic Center Complex – Administration Building Evansville, Indiana

# September 12, 2024

## 1. ROLL CALL

# 2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mike Labitzke made a motion for approval and Thomas Witt seconded the motion; motion carried.

## 3. OLD BUSINESS

## a. Project Update – presented by Pam Drach

## City of Evansville

- <u>Walnut St Phase 2 (Weinbach Ave to Vann Ave)</u>: The project is complete.
- <u>Walnut St Phase 3 (MLK Jr Blvd to US 41)</u>: Contractor has extended reconstruction to Governor. Final asphalt surface is expected to be placed this quarter from US 41 to Garvin St.

## Vanderburgh County

- <u>Oak Hill Rd (Eastwood Dr to Millersburg Rd)</u>: Pipe installation, grading, subbase, curb and gutter, and driveways completed on the east side of Phase 1. The west side work completed includes grading, stabilization, underdrains and subbase installation.
- <u>Oak Hill Rd (Lynch Rd to St George Rd)</u>: Right of way acquisition is ongoing; 8 parcels secured, offers for 17 parcels have been approved. Geotechnical work has started.

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• <u>Wimberg Rd Bridge (over Locust Creek)</u>: A field check was held on August 17.

## **City/County of Henderson**

- <u>Green River Rd (Bend Gate Rd to Osage Dr):</u> Final bid documents have been submitted to KYTC for comment. Additional funding request has been submitted.
- <u>Wathen Lane (US 60 to the City Limits)</u>: Excavating, grading and placement of stone for walking trail is underway. Installation of stormwater structures and associated piping is continuing.

## **INDOT Updates – presented by Luke Hill**

- (R-39921) SR 66 at Epworth Rd: Displaced left turn is open and functioning very well. Some small adjustments to be made.
- (R-42753) I-69 Concrete Pavement Restoration: Over 70% of the project is completed. Slowly opening back up to 2 lanes. I-69 southbound between the 10–15-mile markers will have concrete patching taking place.
- (B-42876) US 41 Pedestrian Walk at Washington Ave: Bridge has been set on abutments; working on ramps. Aesthetics are final. Working on pavement for U-Turns.
- (B-42187) I-64 over abandoned N and S RR: Phase 3 eastbound and westbound deck pours took place in the final week of August. Bridge approaches were poured as well. Project expected to be complete by mid-November.
- (R-41410) US 41 from SR 66/SR 62 (Lloyd) to SR 66 (Diamond): Closed Morgan Ave for 37-day closure. Working on surface asphalt for mainline pavement.
- <u>(R-44898) Intersection Improvements on SR 66 (at Vann, Burkhardt, Cross Pointe, Stockwell)</u>: Vann Ave left turns and signal has been removed. Work on Stockwell Ave median complete. Working through utility conflict on the south. Division St closed September 4, 2024.
- <u>(R-42287) SR 62 Lloyd4U project (improvements west of St Joseph Ave)</u>: Crossovers are close to completion; will shift traffic to the south side of median by October. Utility relocations ongoing.
- (R-45152) SR 62 at Wabash, St Joseph: Working on Stage 3 plans and redetermining utility conflicts. Updating contract documents.
- (R-39923) US 41 at Lynch Rd: Revising and reviewing the project scope and schedule from the consultant. Could potentially be moved back.
- (R-44013) SR 62 Morgan Ave at Boeke Rd and Stockwell Rd: This contract was pushed back to a letting date of February 10, 2027 due to traffic funding.
- (R-44499) US 41 at SR 57, Petersburg Rd, and St George Rd:
  - <u>Petersburg Rd:</u> Stage 1 of plan design was submitted on September 3, 2024. Discussion about moving the letting date due to traffic funds are in process.
  - <u>SR 57:</u> Due to shifting Safe Program prioritization, project letting was moved to January 16, 2030. Stage 1 plans are ongoing and survey is now complete.
  - <u>St George Rd:</u> Due to shifting Safe Program prioritization, project letting was moved to November 15, 2028. Geometry review meeting was held on September 11, 2024 to discuss the displaced left turn.
- Luke Hill also provided an update on I-69 ORX. Barrier walls have been placed on the shoulders of I-69 so they can move on to Phase 3, which is two 11-foot lanes. Phase 3 is intended to start before October. More information can be found online at <a href="https://i69ohiorivercrossing.com/">https://i69ohiorivercrossing.com/</a>.

## b. CY 2024 Call for Projects – presented by Erin Schriefer

In July, the MPO announced the Call for Projects for Indiana LPAs for FY 2031 and beyond. Thirteen applications were received, and all were reviewed following the project selection process that is guided by the goals and objectives set forth in the MTP 2050.

At this time, the MPO is recommending the top project from each Indiana LPA move forward. The following is a summary of these projects:
