VNDERBURGH COUNTY

<u>Columbia-Delaware Bridge over Pigeon Creek:</u> INDOT reviewed the selection documents and gave approval to begin contract negotiations with the consultant for design.

<u>Heckel Road Widening, Green River Road to Oak Hill Road:</u> Blankenberger Bros. provided the low bid of \$3,782,000. The contract was approved at the March 1, 2016 Commissioner's meeting and construction is expected to begin the end of March.

<u>KYTC</u>

<u>US 60, KY 425/Henderson Bypass to Waverly:</u> Henderson Community College to KY 425: Utility coordination is underway.

The Project Update was informational and did not require a committee action.

3. NEW BUSINESS

A. FY 2016-2019 TIP Amendments – presented by Craig Luebke

i. <u>Des # 1592626</u>: US 41: SB weigh station north of Henderson. Update over height equipment. Add project for fiscal year 2016 construction at a cost of \$17,200. Construction costs will be funded with 100% federal STP funds utilizing Kentucky Toll Credits as match.
